Dear Parents and Carers,

By now you will no doubt have heard that school closures will be enforced for all schools with effect from Monday 23rd March. This is with the exception of children of key workers and vulnerable children. Examples of these workers include NHS staff, police and delivery drivers who need to be able to go to work. Vulnerable children include those who have a social worker and those with Education, Health and Care Plans. Children who do not fall into these groups should remain at home with appropriate care.

A full list of key worker categories will be published by the Cabinet Office tomorrow.

This evening the Trust Leadership Team met to discuss these new measures and the practicalities of this. Over the few days we will be communicating with you further to gather essential information and to establish which parents / carers may need this provision.

We will be in touch tomorrow with more information, once we have received further guidance from the Government.


