## Year Six Home Learning

Dear parents and carers,

Welcome back! I hope that you have all had some restful days in the sunshine and enjoyed spending family time together. This will most definitely go down as the most unusual term in educational history, so let's make it the best one yet! As we embark on this journey of Home Learning together, please remember that this is new to all of us. We will all have slightly different approaches to what works best for our children and families, however we aim to provide consistency wherever possible and will, of course, maintain the highest quality provision. We accept that everyone has different work and family commitments, and children with a range of abilities, talents, strengths, passions and skills. So with that in mind, do not be afraid to ask for support with your child's learning.

Please know that parents are not expected to be teachers, but we do ask that you support your child every day to carry out their learning at home whilst the school building is temporarily closed. The aim is to provide you with enough support to be able to work through the activities each day with your child and support them to achieve success.

We have decided to use Seesaw as our Distance Learning platform as it is familiar, user friendly and have great functionality. Activities for the children will be uploaded to their Seesaw activity account, rather than bombarding parents with lots of messages (also a great way that the children can be responsible for their learning - getting ready for secondary school). I will be available to answer all of your Seesaw messages, **Monday to Friday between 09:00-11:00 am**.

Every day, a new learning activity will be set for Maths and grammar/spelling; writing and reading will each have a weekly task. The table below shows the **minimum** amount of time that needs to be spent on each subject area:
