#### **Evidence of impact of Sports Premium Funding 2019-20**

#### Impact affected by COVID-19 interruption to schooling

Impact:

- 1. Active Play Positive feedback on impact from children between September and March. Provision limited by staff availability. Interrupted by COVID-19.
- 2. Sport clubs Data from club registers shows a higher number of children attended sports clubs between September and March.
- 3. Upkeep of purpose-designed, multi-terrain site landscaping to promote sports, and ensure that outdoor learning can be embedded within the curriculum this continued throughout COVID-19 interruption to schooling.
- 4. Promote sporting achievements on Seesaw and school website Seesaw was used well during lockdown to promote a healthy lifestyle and exercise at home, e.g. virtual games. Fitness Star of the Week on newsletter.
- 5. Motivational and aspirational displays and rewards for national and international sporting events and achievements display board in hall used as focal point during weekly celebrations event for Fitness Star of the Week between September and March.
- 6. PE and netball kit for school teams Football kit provided by sponsor Cavannah Homes.
- 7. Health and well-being event did not take place due to COVID-19 interruption to schooling.
- 8. Staff CPD Interrupted by COVID-19. CPD has been identified as a requirement.
- 9. PE resources equipment for Active Play ordered. Positive feedback from children.
- 10. Outside coaches to be employed to run sessions did not take place due to COVID-19 interruption to schooling.
