- In Reception the theme is: Being Special - Where do we belong?

- Year 2 are learning about how Muslims live.
- Year 3 are exploring the question: What is it like to follow God?
- Year 4 are finding about what Hindus believe about what God is like.
- Year 5 are learning why the Torah is important to Jews.
- Year 6 are thinking about the question: Why do some people believe in God and some people not?

What's new? Each week, a class chooses their favourite Christian song or hymn to sing in Hymn Practice. Two children volunteer to write and read their own prayer.
