Reading and phonics

Just before we broke up for the Easter holidays we did our termly reading assessments and it was inspiring to see all of the progress the children have made in their reading this year. Please continue to read with your child on a daily basis and record on See-saw, this support hugely impacts your child's learning. This term all year one children will take part in a national phonics screen. The phonic screen consists of 40 words and non-words that your child will be asked to read one-on-one with a teacher. Your child will need to read these with the correct sounds to show they understand the phonics rules behind them. You can support your child with this by logging into Bug Club and playing the games assigned.
