Talking of pantos, a big well done to Anya, Robin, Élodie, Lilly and Evelyn for outstanding performance in the Abbotsham Pantomime!

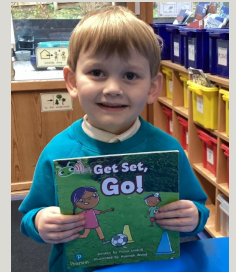
