Community updates:

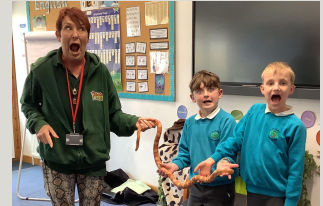
